<u>grade</u>	<u>mark</u>

From 50 to 100, the following algorithm will be applied:

$$\text{QM mark} = [(\text{MELBOURNE mark} - 50) (6/5)] + 40$$

Once you apply the algorithm, the following QM marking bands will be obtained between H1 and P (inclusive):
